



## **Nordic@BETT – Collaboration, Innovation and Technology understanding in schools**

Together with the other Nordic countries - Norway, Sweden and Finland – the Danish National Agency for IT and Learning (STIL) organizes the event Nordic@BETT, on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2019, 2:00 p.m. – 5.00, in Logan Hall, University College London, 20 Bedford Way, Bloomsbury, London.

The Nordic Council of Ministers supports this event again this year, where the Danish CRAFT model for working innovatively with ICT gets a Nordic twist and becomes 'Nordic CRAFT'.

For the Nordic@BETT conference, conducted in the same week as the international exhibition and conference BettShow in London, the four countries focus on how to collaborate on Innovation, Problem solving and other 21<sup>st</sup> century competencies with a strong focus on ICT and Technology understanding. Intermediate and graduate level students and their teachers collaborate across borders with the EU network eTwinning as a supportive platform, and meet for a collaborative effort through hackathons via fiber connections. Nordic@BETT puts innovative teaching on the agenda, and the audience is involved in the afternoon's exciting and educational presentation.
